

BASIS of BEARING

The meridian of this survey is True North and is identical to that of RS. 7-146.

NOTE:

This map is filed to correct the location shown for the 1/4 corner common to Sections 9 and 4 on that Record of Survey filed in Book 10 at Page 85 of Record of Surveys D.R.E.C.

I could find no evidence of the location of the original 1/4 corner. The corner set by R.E.E. 5438 does not fit in many respects or have any supporting appurtenances. I set the monument shown below in 1980 by single proportion. This mon. is still in position.

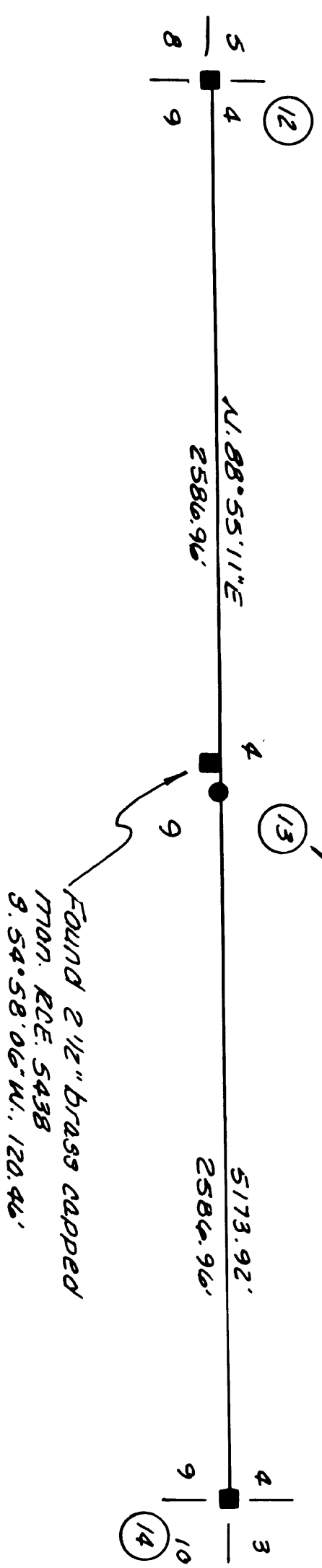

Found 2 1/2" brass capped mon. R.E.E. 5438 S. 54° 58' 06" W., 120.46'

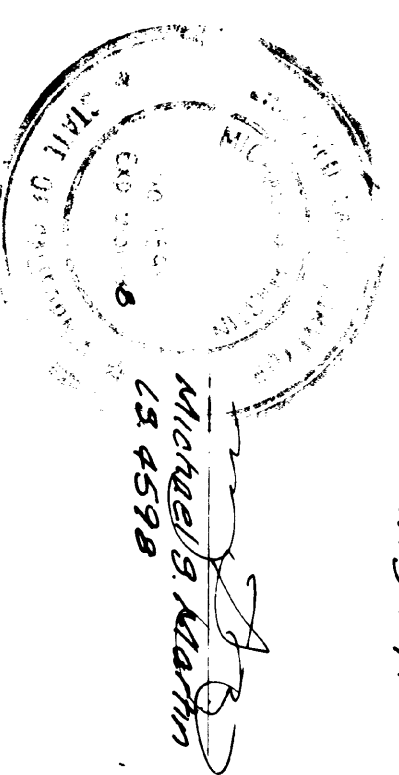
